School Based Rules and Expectations

1. **All vehicles parked in the school parking lot must be registered with the school's security staff. Students must have a parking permit displayed on the dash or hanging from the rear view mirror. The permit number must be visible from outside the vehicle.**
2. **Students who have their parking passes temporarily suspended must pay their fines prior to the pass being returned.**
3. **Students are not allowed to loiter in the parking lot or in their vehicles before, during, or after school hours.**
4. **The Speed Limit on school grounds is 10 MPH.** The vehicle must be operated in a safe and legal manner at all times.
5. Carpools are encouraged. All vehicles used in a carpool must be registered with the school.
6. School parking permits are valid from 7:30 AM until 3:30 PM and are limited to the student parking lot. Note the staff has a reserved parking area on the west side of the main parking lot, and students may not park within this section denoted by the signs.
7. Parking in fire lanes, no parking zones or in restricted areas is prohibited.
8. Violations of rules and expectations may lead to fines, towing, school consequences, and/or law enforcement consequences.
9. Students who intend to carpool and/or drive more than one vehicle on a regular basis may transfer their parking tag from vehicle to vehicle.

Fines

1. Parking in a fire lane - \$20.00 (ticket from law enforcement and towing is possible also)
2. Parking in areas not open to students - \$20.00 (staff or visitor parking, restricted lots, etc.)
3. Non-registered vehicle on school grounds - \$20.00
4. No parking tag displayed - \$10.00
5. Altering, falsifying, transferring without permission a parking tag - \$20.00 and possible suspension or revocation of parking privileges
6. Operating a vehicle in a dangerous or reckless manner on school grounds or in the immediate neighborhood including driving the wrong way in a one way zone - \$30.00 and possible suspension or revocation of parking privileges
7. Loss of parking tag - \$20 to replace it

Students have 10 school days to dispute or contest any fines. Failure to contest a fine within 10 days will lead to the imposition of the fine. All fines should be paid within 30 days and it is the student's responsibility to communicate with parents regarding fines.

Jefferson County Public Schools and Standley Lake High School assume no responsibility for any damage to the vehicles parked on school property or to the loss of any articles contained therein.

Student Driving and Parking Expectations

In order to preserve our campus being safe, we are requiring the following behaviors. These expectations match State Law and are in accordance with all recommendations from police departments, insurance providers and others associated with public safety.

- 1. All students are required to wear seat belts while using a vehicle on school grounds and to and from school events (this expectation is both a State law and a school requirement).**
- 2. Students are not allowed to use their cell phones or other electronic devices while driving their vehicle. In order to maintain an appropriate school environment, we expect students to treat our grounds as they would if they were at home.**
- 3. Trash is not allowed to be left in the parking lot. There are numerous trash cans located near the main entry and students are expected to use them. Failure to do so will result in community service hours cleaning areas of the school.**
