P/SAT Practice Tests

Students can begin practicing now for the April 2024 digital P/SAT assessments. Students can use their College Board account to log into the Bluebook application on their Chromebook to take full-length practice tests from which feedback will be created to help students work towards a stronger score. If your student doesn't have a College Board account, they can create one here. As a reminder, all students must use their Jeffco issued Chromebook device to test this year.
