State Assessments: PSAT 9 & 10

The PSAT 9 or 10 is a test for freshmen and sophomores at every school in the US. This test is used to prepare for the SAT and begin to identify how students would meet math and English competencies for graduation. The information from this test is used by teachers to evaluate skills such as inference, words in context, linear equations and statistics.

The standard test will be 2 hours and 14 minutes in length and is in a <u>digital capacity</u> from now on. The test consists of 98 total questions between both sections. Your student can get on their Chromebook and practice a digital format on Bluebook using their College Board account. 


Opening Reception - Black Futures in Art: Ever Evolving - NoBo Art District
