FEES:

AP/IB Proctors Needed

Our AP/IB testing window is quickly approaching. We will begin AP tests May 1 and conclude with our final late test on May 24.

We are reaching out to ask for help to proctor AP and IB exams. There are many that took advantage of the early sign-up this year, but several slots still remain. Proctors would need to be at the school 30 minutes prior to exam start time and most exams last about 3 hours.
